

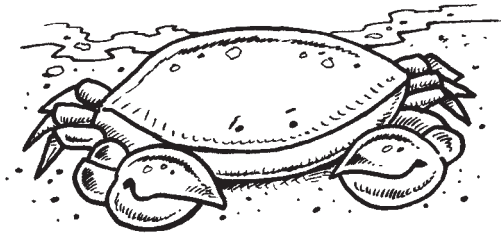
What's at the seaside?

Seahorse

If you are lucky you might see one of these. It is really a kind of fish! Why is it called a horse?

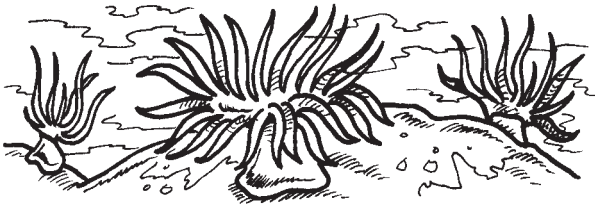


Crab



These are usually a pale colour with hard shells. They have eight legs and little pincers. Do you find them anywhere else beside the seaside?

Sea anemones



When there is no water these look like lumps of red jelly. In the water they open out like little flowers to catch food. Are they plants or animals?

Barnacles



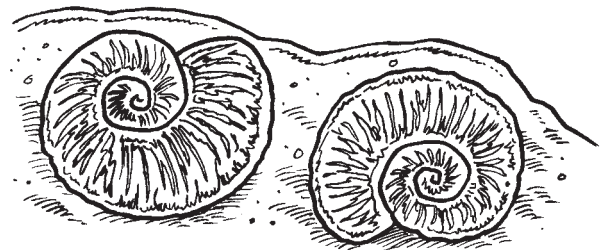
These seem to grow everywhere underwater – on ships, on the pier, on rope, on rock. Are they plants or animals? How can you find out?

Bucket and spade

You can use these for making sandcastles, collecting shells, digging for worms or collecting animals. You should always put animals back again afterwards. Why do you think this is?

You will find these in the rocks sometimes. Are they alive? Were they once alive? Do they remind you of anything?
