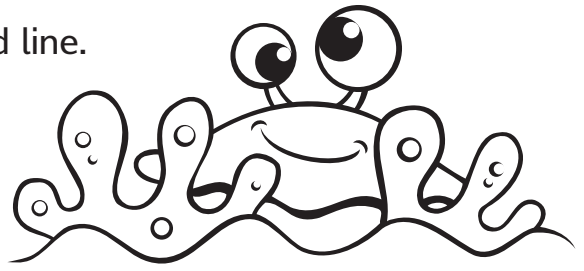


# Seaside plant hunt
