

# Beach creature hunt

## You will need

Metal spoon; plastic see-through pot with lid; magnifying glass; information and reference books.



- Search on the beach for creatures. Carefully move stones and use your spoon to dig for them in the sand!
- If you find something, use your spoon to gently pick your creature up and place it in a container. Put on the lid.
- Use a magnifying glass to look at your creature. Can you identify it?

Draw and label creatures you have found living on the beach.
