

Whole-class story book

This is a simple design for a book which each member of the class can contribute a page (see pages 18–19 for extended activity ideas).

- Provide the class with the opening line of a story that presents children with a range of possibilities, for example, *Last night I found something I hadn't seen for a very long time...*
- Each child in the class takes a turn to

contribute a line to the story leading it to a conclusion, before illustrating their line and making their own page for the book.

- Draft the book on to sheets of A4 before making a larger version, perhaps with painted or printed pictures. These can then be stuck on to the folded pages of the book. Make sure that the total number of pages is a multiple of four (see below).
- Fasten the pages together with string or sew them together.
