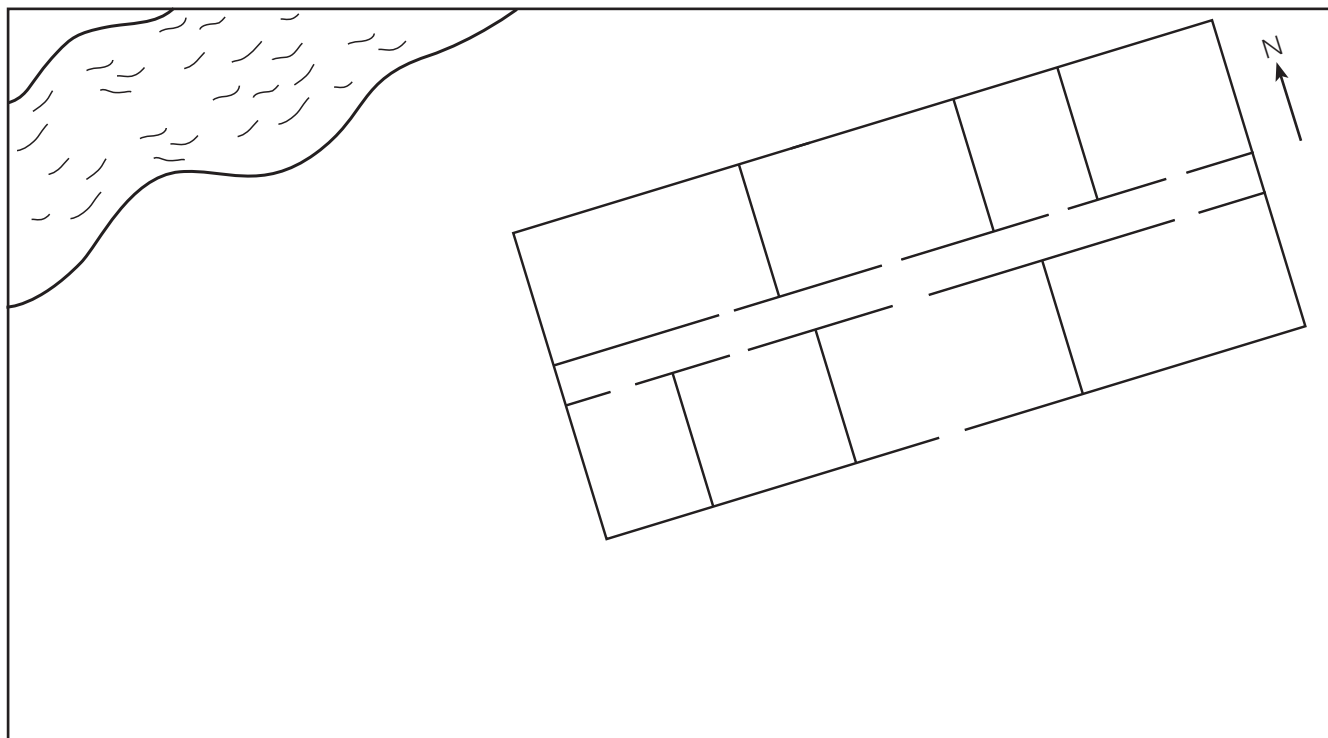


My plan of a Roman villa

- Look at the plan of the villa. Can you add the rooms you already know about? (culina, peristylum and triclinium).
- What other rooms might there have been? Label those too.



- A river runs along the back of the villa. The owner has decided to build a bathhouse. He will need four rooms:
 1. The praefurnium (the furnace room), where the water is heated. Only slaves work here.
 2. The frigidarium (the cold room). This is the first room the bathers enter.
 3. The tepidarium (the warm room). There isn't a bath in here, but bathers can store their clothes here and oil themselves.
 4. The caldarium (the hot room). Phew it's very hot in here! Slaves will scrape the oil, dirt and sweat off the bathers before they enter the hot bath. Afterwards they go back and plunge themselves into the cold bath.

Add the bathhouse to the plan of the villa and label the rooms.
