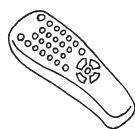
You can help to cut down the amount of energy used at school and in your home. Take our quick test and count how many things you do already. What will you pledge to do in the future?

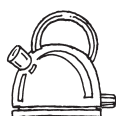
