



*Easy:* What happened to the monasteries under Henry VIII?  
**They were dissolved**, new ones opened or they were turned into schools



*Medium:* In which year were the smaller monasteries dissolved?  
 1534, **1536** or 1538

*Hard:* Name three things that happened when a monastery was dissolved:  
**Monks sent away, buildings destroyed, books and paintings stolen or burned, ornaments melted down, statues smashed**

*Easy:* How many wives did Henry VIII have?  
**Six**, eight or four



*Medium:* Which two wives were beheaded?  
 Catherine of Aragon, **Anne Boleyn**, Jane Seymour, Anne of Cleves, **Catherine Howard** or Catherine Parr

*Hard:* Which three wives bore Henry VIII a child?  
**Catherine of Aragon, Anne Boleyn, Jane Seymour**, Anne of Cleves, Catherine Howard or Catherine Parr

*Easy:* Which Tudor King made himself head of the church?  
 Henry VII, **Henry VIII** or Edward VI



*Medium:* What title was granted to Henry VIII by the Pope in 1521?  
**Defender of the faith**, Supporter of the Faith or Supporter of the Church

*Hard:* In which year did the Pilgrimage of Grace take place?  
 1534, **1536** or 1540

*Easy:* Which one of Henry VIII's children became the ruler of England immediately after his death?  
 Mary Tudor, Elizabeth I or **Edward VI**



*Medium:* What happened in 1549 in Norwich?  
**The Kett's Rebellion**, the Pilgrimage of Grace or the Babington Plot

*Hard:* Who was Edward VI's first Protector?  
 The Duke of Northumberland or **the Duke of Somerset**

*Easy:* Who did Mary Tudor marry?  
**Philip of Spain**, the Duke of Alencon or the Duke of Parma



*Medium:* Who was the Nine Day Queen?  
 Mary Tudor, **Lady Jane Grey** or Elizabeth I

*Hard:* Which town in France was lost by the English during Mary's reign?  
 Boulogne, **Calais** or Le Havre

*Easy:* What was the name given to the stiff collars worn during Elizabeth's reign?  
**Ruffs**



*Medium:* Did men wear trousers or breeches?  
**Breeches**

*Hard:* In 1571, a law was passed requiring everyone over the age of six to wear a certain piece of clothing on Sundays. What was it?  
**A hat**, a cape or a ruff

*Easy:* Who was the most famous playwright of Elizabethan times?  
**William Shakespeare**



*Medium:* Where was Shakespeare born?  
**Stratford-upon-Avon**

*Hard:* Name two plays written by Shakespeare.
