

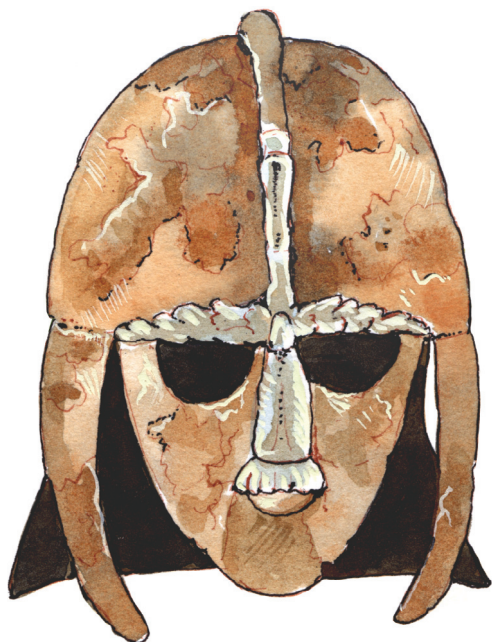
# Artefact adverts 1

The helmet is beautifully decorated with pictures of warriors holding spears.

## Purse lid

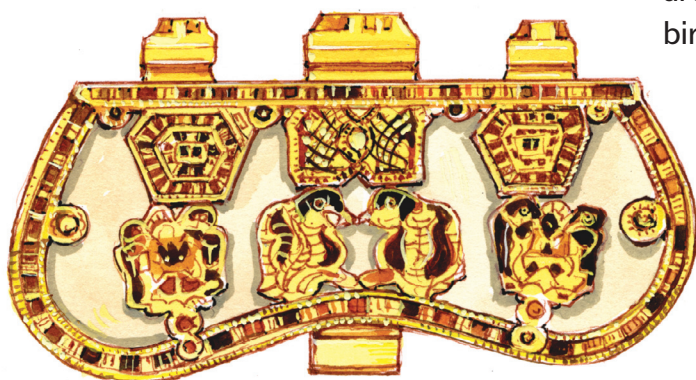

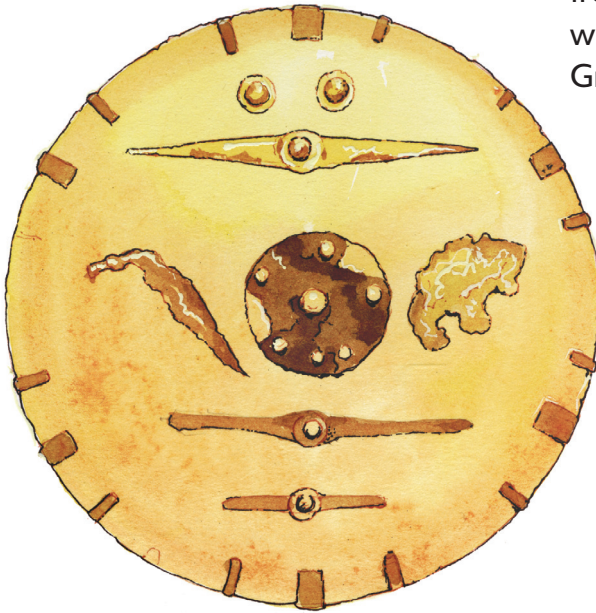
# Artefact adverts 3

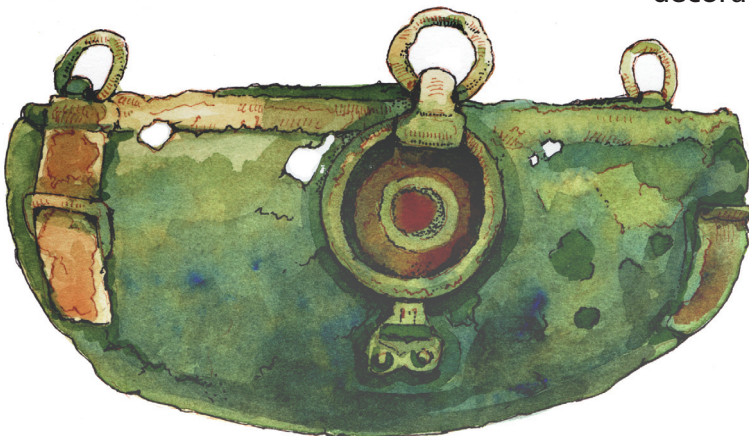
