1788: Construction starts on the Brandenburg Gate

1806: Napoleon marches through Berlin on his way to Russia

1945: Soviet troops capture Berlin to end the Second World War

2006: Final of the World Cup held in Berlin's Olympic Stadium

1307: Berlin founded as a trading post on the River Spree

1989: Berlin Wall pulled down

1740: Frederick the Great comes to power and turns Berlin into a major capital city

1961: Construction of the Berlin Wall that splits the city into two

1990: Berlin again becomes the capital of a reunited Germany

1933: Reichstag parliament building destroyed by fire
